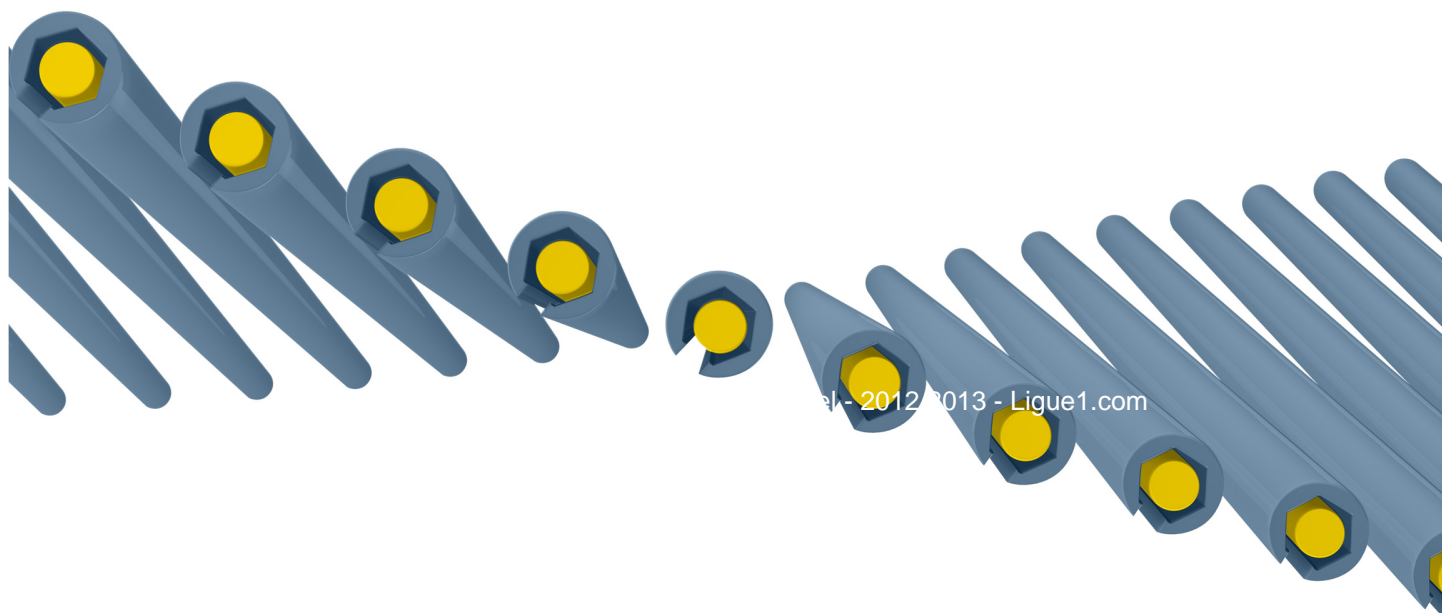

PREVIEW : PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN - EVIAN TG FC

Paris Saint-Germain - Evian TG FC Feature Preview

Buoyed by topping their Champions League group, Paris Saint-Germain must now set about correcting their Ligue 1 form as three defeats in their last five games have seen them drop from first to fourth.

Coach Carlo Ancelotti had announced there'd be "radical changes" after the 2-1 Week 15 loss at Nice that left PSG five points off the division pace being set by Lyon, who travel to the Parc des Princes on December 16. This Saturday's visitors to the capital are 17-th placed Evian and it will be interesting to see whether Ancelotti persists with the 4-4-2 formation that proved effective against Porto in the 2-1 win at the stadium on Tuesday.

Javier Pastore featured on the left of midfield and Ezequiel Lavezzi on the right behind a front two composed of Ligue 1 top scorer Zlatan Ibrahimovic and Jérémy Ménez. Argentinian international Pastore enjoyed arguably his best match of the season and the speed with which PSG adapted to the tactical tweak surprised even captain Thiago Silva, the scorer of the club's first in the Porto win. The Brazilian international centre-half said: "We'd only had one training session with this formation and, to be honest, I didn't think it would work as it meant playing with four attacking players."

Ancelotti will be forced into making a change in central midfield with French international Blaise Matuidi suspended after his red card at Nice. Brazilian-born Italian international Thiago Motta is poised to make a timely return from injury in his place.

PSG were 4-0 home winners over Troyes in their most recent Ligue 1 fixture at the Parc des Princes but that came off the back of home losses to Saint-Etienne and Rennes that damaged PSG's bid for a first title since 1994. After the Porto victory, Ancelotti said: "Against a good Porto side, I saw everything I wanted to see from my players. This side has pride and quality. It's always difficult to build a side quickly. I'm confident."

Evian may stand just a point and a place above the drop zone but their current unbeaten run of four games - two wins and two draws - is their best streak of the season. Coach Pascal Dupraz said: "PSG away is one of the easiest games to prepare for. I think the players will be really motivated for it. After the PSG game, we play Troyes and that's a match which will be worth its weight in gold given our position in the table."

Evian have yet to record a draw on their travels this season and have won all three away dates in which they have scored the first goal. On how to keep quiet Ligue 1 top scorer Zlatan Ibrahimovic - plunderer of 13 goals this season - Dupraz joked: "Maybe I should organise a traffic jam on the Paris ring road so that he arrives late at the ground! More than focusing on an individual player, we need to focus on all the high-quality individuals PSG have and find a way to stop them."

It will be a special day for Evian full-back Brice Dja Djédjé, who came up through the PSG youth system. Scorer of a lovely goal in ETG's 1-1 home draw with Nancy last time out, Dja Djédjé said: "It's always nice to play against your former club but I'm not going to place any additional pressure on myself. We can cause them problems. I speak regularly to Mamadou Sakho, but often about things other than football. I congratulate him when he gets called up by France and he congratulates me when I get called up by the Côte d'Ivoire. He also congratulated me for my goal against Nancy!"



**Paris Saint-Germain - Evian TG FC**

- HISTORY: PSG won their only previous Ligue 1 home meeting with Evian 3-1 in Week 22 of the 2011-2012 season. Nene (47' and 78' pen.) and Kevin Gameiro (89') scored the PSG goals. Cédric Cambon (45+1') got the Evian goal.
- Evian held PSG 2-2 in Annecy in Week 6. Ex-PSG man Jérôme Leroy (14') and Yannick Sagbo (20') scored for Evian. Javier Pastore (43') and sub Mathieu Bodmer (80') salvaged a point for PSG.
- PARIS SAINT-GERMAIN:
- GENERAL: PSG are fourth in Ligue 1 with 26 points from 15 games (7W, 5D, 3L).
- PSG have lost three of their last five league games and slipped from top to fourth. PSG lost 2-1 at Nice in Week 15. Eric Bauthéac (76') and Valentin Eysseric (86') scored for Nice. Zlatan Ibrahimovic (82') got the PSG goal, his Ligue 1-leading 13th of the season. Blaise Matuidi (90+3') was sent off in stoppage time for a second yellow card. It was PSG's first away defeat of the season.
- They had gone 15 Ligue 1 games without losing before succumbing 2-1 at home to Saint-Etienne in Week 11, their first defeat in 17 home league games since a 1-0 reverse at the hands of AS Nancy Lorraine on November 20, 2011.
- PSG's league record under Carlo Ancelotti now reads: 18W, 11D, 5L
- PSG are joint-third in the attack table with 24 goals.
- Ibrahimovic has scored 13 goals in 12 starts and also added two assists. Gameiro is second in the scoring stakes with three. He has scored doubles in five games.
- Nene and Javier Pastore have the most assists at the club with four each.
- PSG have scored 2998 goals in all competitions.
- PSG have the second-best defensive record in the division with 12 goals conceded.
- They have kept eight clean sheets already, and have not conceded more than two goals in any one league game since a 4-3 win at Valenciennes on May 6.
- Midfielder Matuidi is the only man to have featured in all 15 league games.
- PSG are 19th in the Fair Play table with 35 yellow cards and four red cards this season. Ezequiel Lavezzi (v Ajaccio, Wk 2) , Zlatan Ibrahimovic (v Saint-Etienne, Wk 11), Mamadou Sakho (v Montpellier, Wk12), and Blaise Matuidi (v Nice, Wk15).
- HOME FORM: PSG are seventh in the home form table with 14 points from eight matches (4W, 2D, 2L).
- The Saint-Etienne loss mentioned above was Ancelotti's first home L1 defeat as PSG coach.
- Four of PSG's 13 goals at home were scored in the 4-0 win over Troyes in Week 14.
- PSG have won all four home games in which they've opened the scoring, but have managed just a single point from the three in which they conceded the opening goal.
- PSG have the highest average attendance this season at 42,356.
- COUPE DE LA LIGUE: As one of France's European representatives, PSG were handed a bye directly through to the last 16, where they beat holders Marseille 2-0. They will now go to Saint-Etienne in the quarter-finals on November 27.
- CHAMPIONS LEAGUE: PSG sealed top spot in Group A with a 2-1 home win over Porto on Matchday 6 on Tuesday evening.
- Captain Thiago Silva (29') put PSG ahead, before Jackson Martinez (33') equalised. Ezequiel Lavezzi (61') scored the winner.
- They sealed their place in the last 16 with a 2-0 win at Dynamo Kiev on Matchday 5 courtesy of two goals by Ezequiel Lavezzi (45', 52').
- PSG kicked-off their campaign with a 4-1 win at home to Dynamo Kyiv. After losing 1-0 away to FC Porto, they recorded back-to-back wins against Dinamo Zagreb. A 2-0 victory in Croatia was followed by a 4-0 win at the Parc des Princes.
- SUSPENSIONS: Marco Verratti and Blaise Matuidi are suspended. Verratti has been carrying a groin injury in any case.
- INJURIES: Thiago Motta is poised to feature for the first time since Week 12. Kevin Gameiro (back) has been absent of late.





- EVIAN:
- GENERAL: Evian are 17th in Ligue 1 with 16 points (4W, 4D, 7L). They were in the relegation zone at the end of Week 13 before climbing out of it with four points in the last two games.
- In Week 15 Evian drew 1-1 at home to Nancy. Brice Dja Djedjé opened the scoring in the 43rd minute. Yohan Mollo (50') equalised for the bottom club.
- Evian are unbeaten in their last four matches (2W, 2D), which is their best run of the season.
- Evian are 13th in the attack table with 17 goals scored. They've scored in each of their last five games.
- Saber Khlifa is club top scorer with five goals. Cédric Barbosa is next with three goals.
- Yannick Sagbo and Kévin Bérigaud have three assists each.
- Evian are 16th in the defence table with 23 goals conceded.
- Evian have kept two clean sheets this season in the 3-0 win over Bastia in Week 5 and the 1-0 win at Rennes in Week 14.
- Evian are 10th in the Fair Play table with 31 yellow cards and no red cards.
- AWAY FORM: Evian are ninth in the away form table with nine points from seven games (3W, 0D, 4L).
- They have won all three away games in which they have scored first.
- Evian hadn't kept a clean sheet for eight away games prior to the 1-0 win at Rennes.
- Bérigaud has scored five of his seven goals in his L1 career away.
- Evian and Marseille are the only Ligue 1 clubs without an away draw this season.
- COUPE DE LA LIGUE: Evian lost 3-2 at Sochaux in the Round of 32 after extra-time.
- SUSPENSIONS: Olivier Sorlin was suspended for the Nancy game.
- INJURIES: Cédric Cambon, Ali M'Madi and Jonathan Mensah (thigh) all missed the Nancy game injured.

Paris Saint-Germain

- Promoted to the French first division for the first time in 1974, PSG are the only French club never to have been relegated from Ligue 1, and are taking part in their 37th consecutive season in the top flight.
- Ligue 1 champions in 1986 and 1994, PSG have won eight French Cups (1982, '83, '93, '95, '98, 2004, '06, '10) and three League Cups (1993, '98, 2008).
- PSG last piece of silverware came when they beat Monaco 1-0 in the 2009-10 French Cup final - Guillaume Hoarau scored the only goal of the game in the 105th minute.
- Since the relegation of Red Star 93 in 1975, Paris FC in 1983 and Racing Club de France (Matra Racing) in 1990, PSG are the only Ligue 1 side in the French capital.
- Season 2007-08 was the worst in the club's Ligue 1 history, finishing 16th and saving their place amongst the elite on the penultimate week of the season. However, they qualified for the UEFA Cup thanks to their League Cup victory.
- Paris-SG are only the second French club to win a European cup thanks to their 1-0 triumph over Rapid Vienna in the 1996 UEFA Cup Winners' Cup - Bruno N'Gotty scoring the only goal of the game. Marseille were the first, winning the 1993 European Cup (Champions League) with a 1-0 defeat of AC Milan.
- On November 4, 2008, PSG opened a brand-new training complex at the Camp des Loges, which cost six million Euros.
- In May 2011, Paris Saint-Germain announced that Qatari investors had bought a controlling 70% stake in the club, ending months of speculation about who the Ligue 1 outfit's new owners would be.





- The Qatar Investment Authority, an investment arm, of the Qatari government, bought out the former owners, the American group Colony Capital.
- In March 2012 QIA became the sole shareholder of the club after purchasing the remaining 30% stake held by Colony Capital and Butler Capital Partners.
- Nasser Al-Khelaifi, the President of Aljazeera sports who had invested heavily in Ligue 1 television rights, become President of the club, in July 2011 he named former PSG, Milan, Inter and Brazil midfielder Leonardo Director of Football.
- Last summer PSG spent a then-Ligue 1 record fee of 43 million Euros to sign Javier Pastore from Palermo, the Argentine midfielder joined by the likes of Mohamed Sissoko, Salvatore Sirigu, Diego Lugano and Jeremy Ménez at the Parc des Princes.
- Coach Antoine Kombouaré, who joined from Valenciennes in May 2009, remained at the helm until Christmas, but despite steering the club to the top of the table at the Winter break, he was sacked.
- The popular Kombouaré was replaced by Sporting director Leonardo's friend Carlo Ancelotti who had been out of work after being sacked by Chelsea despite having won the English League and Cup double in the 2009/10 season.
- In January 2012 Inter and Brazil midfielder Thiago Motta joined for a fee of around 10 million Euros.
- The second half of last season saw PSG engaged in a title tussle with Montpellier, but a bad run from Week 29 to 32 saw them lose momentum.
- In that period PSG drew with Bordeaux (1-1, Wk 29) and bottom club Auxerre (1-1, Wk 32), lost to Nancy (2-1, Wk 31) only their only win coming against Marseille (2-1, Wk 30).
- PSG finished second, three points behind Montpellier. It was an improvement on their fourth place finish the season before.
- PSG have been easily the most active in the 2012 summer transfer market.
- Like in 2011, Leonardo has looked to Italy for his acquisitions.
- Argentine striker Ezequiel Lavezzi (27) signed in July on a 30 million euro, four year deal from Lazio.
- Milan's Brazilian star Thiago Silva (27) then became the world's most expensive defender when he signed a five-year deal from AC Milan for a fee of 42 million Euros in July.
- Then Swedish striker Zlatan Ibrahimovic - also from AC Milan - put pen to paper on a three-year, 24 million euro deal. The 30-year-old is on reported wages of 14 million Euros a year(after tax) which some in the French Socialist government labelled as "indecent".
- On the same day Ibrahimovic signed, Italy's U-21 midfield star Marco Verratti, whom some have compared to Andrea Pirlo, joined from promoted Serie A side Pescara for a fee of around 11 million Euros.
- PSG's summer spending topped the 100 million Euros mark
- Three players returned in the summer of 2012 from loan spells: midfielder Granddi Ngoyi (Nantes), Haiti striker Jean-Eudes Maurice (Lens) and France U-20 defender Loïck Landre (Clermont Foot)
- Ngoyi was then sold to Troyes, 20-year old goalkeeper Mickaël Salamone joined Evian on a two-year deal, 19-year old striker Jimmy Kamghain moved to Belgium to play for KV Courtrai.
- Brazilian defender Marcos Ceara's contract expired and was not renewed
- Nene was PSG's top scorer in the 2011-12 season with 21 goals (nine penalties). Next best was Pastore with 13.
- Ménez created the most assists with 13.
- Average home attendance 40, 822 (90% of capacity)





Evian TG FC

- This is Evian-Thonon-Gaillard's second season in the top flight. They finished an impressive ninth in their debut Ligue 1 campaign in 2011-12.
- Evian were promoted to the top flight for the first time in the club's history after winning the Ligue 2 title in their first season at that level in 2010-11.
- The present-day club first appeared under the guise of Football Croix-de-Savoie 74 in 2003, following the amalgamation of two local clubs.
- Another merger in 2007 saw Croix-de-Savoie team up with Olympique Thonon-Gablais. A move from their home in Gaillard to Thonon-lès-Bains followed, and after winning promotion to the third-tier Championnat National in 2009, the club were rechristened Evian-Thonon-Gaillard.
- The club represent the towns of Evian-lès-Bains and Thonon-lès-Bains, both on the southern shore of Lake Lemman (Lake Geneva), and Gaillard, which is effectively a suburb of the Swiss city of Geneva, albeit lying just across the border.
- Franck Riboud, president of the Danone food processing multinational, became honorary president of the club in 2009.
- French World Cup winners Zinedine Zidane, Bixente Lizarazu and Alain Boghossian are all minor shareholders in the club.
- Without a stadium of their own that is able to host Ligue 1 or Ligue 2 football, Evian-TG FC currently rent the 15,690-capacity Parc des Sports in Annecy, around 80 kilometres southwest of Evian.
- Pascal Dupraz took over as coach from Uruguayan Pablo Correa on September 3 2012. Former Nancy coach Pablo Correa had only replaced Bernard Casoni as coach in January 2012.
- It is Dupraz's first coaching role in the professional game and he stepped up from sporting director. Dupraz coached earlier versions of the club FC Gaillard and Croix-de-Savoie and has been associated with the outfit in some capacity since 1991. He was moved to sporting director from coach in 2009.
