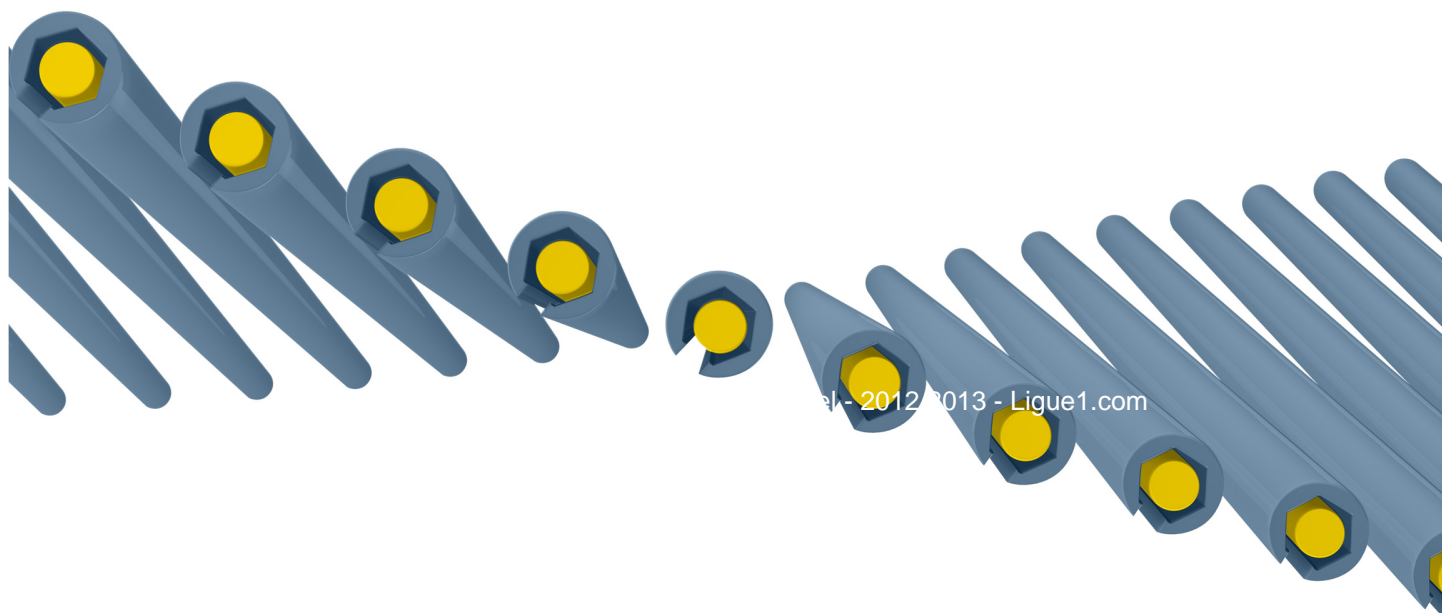

PREVIEW : OLYMPIQUE DE MARSEILLE - AS NANCY-LORRAINE

Olympique de Marseille - AS Nancy-Lorraine Feature Preview

Olympique de Marseille must put the forthcoming double confrontation with Paris Saint-Germain to the back of their mind when they host bottom club AS Nancy-Lorraine at the Stade Vélodrome on Sunday evening.

A 2-1 win at Rouen (National, D3) in the Round of 32 of the French Cup on Wednesday set up a Round of 16 clash at Paris Saint-Germain on Wednesday February 27, a mere three days after the title rivals meet at the Parc des Princes in Ligue 1. PSG disposed of OM 2-0 at the Round of 16 stage of the Coupe de la Ligue in the capital, while André-Pierre Gignac and Zlatan Ibrahimovic both scored doubles in the 2-2 Ligue 1 draw on the south coast. It will only be the second time in history that OM will have played PSG four times in a single season, the previous time being in 1974-1975.

OM coach Elie Baup said: "It's exceptional but my only regret is that the draw means we'll have played both Cup ties at their ground and not at home. Winning becomes a habit and I'm not inventing anything by saying that. The Rouen game had everything reunited to be a banana skin, what with the atmosphere and our opponents. We avoided the trap even if we again had problems defending set-pieces."

Baup had the satisfaction of seeing new signing Modou Sougou mark his first OM appearance since joining from Romanian club CFR Cluj with a fortuitous goal, the pacy Sougou slipping as he made contact with the ball and Rouen keeper Théo Defourny, on loan from Olympique Lyonnais, deemed to have carried the ball over the line. Senegalese wide man Sougou has been likened to Jonathan Pitroïpa of Rennes in style and impressed Baup with his debut on the right of the OM attack: "He worked hard on his flank. He takes the ball well and did some good things. It augurs well for the future even if he's not yet 100% physically after a long winter break."

January signing Foued Kadir's Algeria have been knocked out of the Africa Cup of Nations, but OM will have to wait a bit longer for fellow mercato capture Jacques-Alaixys Romao (Togo) and long-serving midfielder Charles Kaboré (Burkina Faso) to return from South Africa.

Nancy interim coach Patrick Gabriel said his club's survival chances had risen from 2% to 4% after the long-awaited second victory of the season, a 2-1 win at home to Lorient being their first since the opening day of the season and the 1-0 home success against Brest, which remains Ligue 1's basement club's only clean sheet of the campaign.

Gabriel's charges have been rather more effective in front of goal of late - Nancy having scored in every game since a 1-0 loss to PSG in Week 10 - and Cameroonian forward Paul Alo'o Efoulou has been leading the way in 2013 with four goals in as many appearances in all competitions. Frozen out under Gabriel's predecessors Jean Fernandez and Pablo Correa, Alo'o Efoulou marked his first league start since December 2010 with Nancy's opener against Lorient.

Gabriel said: "Paul is a fox in the box; he's adroit in front of goal, gets in the box and has that rare quality for an attacker of often being in the right place at the right time when the ball falls to stick the chance away. His one defect is that he needs the team to play for him; he needs us to play high up the pitch so he can get into the box. In the last two years he's suffered a lot but I've put him back in and he's shown up well. If we play from deeper then we need someone who can run in behind and use the space on the break and that's where Benjamin Moukandjo and Djamel Bakar are strong. If we're higher up the pitch then Paul is more useful. There are tactical choices to be made."

Alo'o Efoulou added: "When you're a competitor you want to give what you can for the team. I'm happy. If I hadn't had the week with two goals in the French Cup and then one in the league, then maybe things wouldn't be going the way they are. Now things are positive. I've always been of the attitude that you have to fight no matter what."



**Olympique de Marseille - AS Nancy-Lorraine**

- HISTORY: OM have hosted Nancy 24 times in Ligue 1. OM have won 12, Nancy five, and there have been seven draws.
- OM have won the last three encounters at the Stade Vélodrome and Nancy's shock 3-0 win in 2008-2009 was their only victory at OM in their last 11 league visits (8 OM W plus 2 D both by 2-2 scoreline).
- LAST SEASON: OM won 1-0 in Week 35 of the season with Loïc Rémy scoring the only goal in the 31st minute. Joël Sami was sent off for Nancy after the final whistle for dissent.
- THIS SEASON: In Week 5 OM were 1-0 winners at Nancy with Jordan Ayew netting in the 53rd minute, scoring with an unstoppable diving header from a left-wing centre supplied by his elder brother André.
- MARSEILLE:
- GENERAL: OM are third in the L1 table with 42 points from 22 matches (13W, 3D, 6L).
- In Week 22 OM drew 2-2 at Rennes. OM led twice in the game through André Ayew (37') and Jordan Ayew (82') but Rennes managed to equalise on both occasions through Kévin Théophile-Catherine (59') and Romain Alessandrini (88').
- OM team v Rennes: Mandanda; Fanni, Nkoulou, Lucas Mendes, Morel; Barton, Cheyrou (Amalfitano (72')); J. Ayew, Valbuena, A. Ayew; Gignac
- OM came into Week 23 with the same number of wins as leading duo PSG and OL but having lost twice as many games as the top two.
- They won their first six league games in a row, becoming the first club to achieve such a feat since AS Monaco in 1960-61. However, they have won seven and lost six of their subsequent 16 matches.
- After 22 matches last season OM were fifth on 38 points, 11 points behind leaders PSG.
- In their title-winning 2009-10 season, OM were fourth on 39 points at this stage, nine behind leaders Bordeaux.
- Elie Baup's side topped the table from Week 3, but slipped back to second after losing at Troyes in Week 9. They have not been lower than sixth all season.
- OM are joint-eighth in the attack table with 30 goals scored. Only Bordeaux (24) of the top ten clubs have scored fewer goals.
- They have failed to score in three league games. They have scored three goals on two occasions - the 3-1 win against Rennes in Week 4, and the 3-2 victory over Montpellier in Week 21.
- André-Pierre Gignac, André Ayew and Jordan Ayew all have seven goals each in the league. Gignac has 12 in all competitions, while André Ayew and Jordan Ayew each have ten altogether.
- Mathieu Valbuena with seven assists, two of them from set-pieces, is joint-top of the Ligue 1 assists chart with seven.
- OM are joint-eighth in the defence table with 27 goals conceded. They have kept nine clean sheets, but have conceded three goals or more on four occasions: the 4-1 losses at Valenciennes (Wk 7) and at home to Lyon (Wk 10) as well as the 3-1 defeat at Sochaux (Wk21).
- Nicolas Nkoulou, Steve Mandanda, Jérémy Morel and Valbuena have all started every Ligue 1 game so far this season.
- OM are second in the Fair Play table with 30 yellow cards and three red cards. Mendes (v Bordeaux, Wk 13), Rod Fanni (v Lyon, Wk 10) and Charles Kaboré (v Lorient, Wk 16) are the three OM players to have been sent off in Ligue 1 this season.
- Just ten of OM's goals have been scored in the first half and if matches finished at half-time they would be eighth in the table. PSG and OM would still be the leading duo, locked together on 40 points, some ten points better off than OM.
- HOME FORM: OM are eighth in the home form table with 20 points from 10 games (6W, 2D, 2L). They have played two fewer home fixtures than PSG and one fewer than OL heading into Week 23.
- OM's home wins have come against Sochaux (2-0, Wk 2), Rennes (3-1, Wk 4), Evian TG (1-0, Wk 6), LOSC Lille (1-0, Wk 14) and Saint-Etienne (1-0, Wk 19) and Montpellier (3-2, Wk21).
- They have drawn with Paris Saint-Germain (2-2, Wk 8) and OGC Nice (2-2, Wk 12). Defeats have come against Lyon (1-4, Wk 10)





and FC Lorient (0-3, Wk 16).

- Before the losses against OL and Lorient, OM had never lost two home matches back-to-back by a three-goal margin.

- The Stade Vélodrome is currently being redeveloped and OM have the third-highest average attendance in L1 (behind PSG and Lille) at 33,950.

- COUPE DE LA LIGUE: As one of France's European representatives, holders Marseille earned a bye directly through to the last 16, where they were beaten 2-0 away by Paris Saint-Germain.

- OM had won the Coupe de la Ligue in each of the last three seasons, winning 12 successive ties in the competition.

- COUPE DE FRANCE: Marseille's Round of 32 tie at third-tier FC Rouen 1899, originally scheduled for Tuesday January 22, was called off following a major gas leak in the Normandy city. The match was rescheduled for Jan 30 with a sell-out 12,000 crowd seeing OM win 2-1. Valbuena (42') and Modou Sougou (59'), on his OM debut, scored the goals. Rémy Dugimont made OM sweat as he pulled one back for Rouen in the 67th minute.

- OM team v Rouen: Mandanda; Fanni, Diawara, Nkoulou, Lucas Mendes (Abdallah 89'); Amalfitano, Barton, Cheyrou; Sougou (Gignac 69'), J. Ayew, Valbuena (A. Ayew 74')

- OM beat Ligue 2 side EA Guingamp 2-1 after extra time in the Round of 64.

- OM are at PSG in the Round of 16 with the match to be played on February 27, three days after the clubs meet at the Parc des Princes in Ligue 1. It will be only the second time in history that OM will have played PSG four times in a single season, the previous time being in 1974-1975.

-EUROPA LEAGUE: Marseille were eliminated in the group stage after finishing third in Group C with five points, six points adrift of second-placed Borussia Mönchengladbach. Their only win was a 5-1 home victory against AEL Limassol of Cyprus.

-INTERNATIONALS: Charles Kaboré (Burkina Faso) and new signing Foued Kadir (Algeria) have both been called up by their countries to take part in the Africa Cup of Nations. Burkina Faso face Togo in the quarter-finals on Sunday, while Algeria were eliminated after finishing bottom of Group D. New signing Jacques-Alaixys Romao is at the competition with Togo.

- Steve Mandanda and Mathieu Valbuena have been named in the France squad to take on Germany in a friendly at the Stade de France on February 6.

- JANUARY TRANSFERS IN: Brice Samba (Le Havre AC), Foued Kadir (Valenciennes FC), Modou Sougou (CFR 1907 Cluj, ROM), Jacques-Alaixys Romao (Lorient)

- OUT: Loïc Rémy (Queens Park Rangers, ENG), Senah Mango (Uzès-Pont-Garde, six-month loan), Florian Raspentino (Stade Brestois 29, six-month loan), Pape Mbow (Amiens, six-month loan)

- INJURIES: Jérémy Morel missed the Rouen Cup win with a hip injury. Lucas Mendes required stitches after blood was drawn in a challenge with Régis Dugimont.

- NANCY:

- GENERAL: Nancy are bottom of the table with 15 points from 22 matches (2W, 9D, 11L).

- In Week 22 Nancy recorded their first L1 win since the opening day of the season (1-0 v Brest). Nancy endured 11L and 9D before their 2-1 home success against Lorient and left the winless L1 record with Arles-Avignon (23 in 10-11).

- Paul Alo'o Efoulou (36') and Sébastien Puygrenier (71') scored for Nancy v FCL, for whom Jérémie Aliadière had equalised (50'). It was Alo'o Efoulou's first L1 start for Nancy since December 2010 and Puygrenier's first as captain since succeeding the departed André Luiz.

- Nancy team v Lorient: Gregorini; Sané, Puygrenier, Jeanvier; Jebbour, Mangani, Grange (Hammar 80'), Murtatori; Karaboué (Ayasse 87'), Bakar; Alo'o Efoulou (Moukandjo 73').

- Nancy have taken four points from their three league games under interim coach Patrick Gabriel. He also enjoyed a penalty shootout win at Nice to qualify the Lorraine club for the Round of 16 of the Coupe de France.





- This time last season Nancy were 15th with 23 points from 22 games.
- Only Reims (18) have scored fewer times than Nancy's 20.
- Nancy did not score between Week 2 and Week 9, but the Week 10 shutout in a 1-0 home loss to PSG in Week 10 was the last time they failed to score in any game.
- Sébastien Puygrenier, Djamel Bakar and Yohan Mollo (now on loan at Saint-Etienne) have all scored three in the league for ASNL.
- Paul Alo'o Efoulou has scored four goals in his last four appearances in all competitions.
- Romain Grange has supplied two assists.
- Only Troyes (43) and Bastia (47) have conceded more than Nancy's 38.
- Nancy have conceded in each of their last 21 league matches since opening the season with their solitary clean sheet in the 1-0 home win over Brest.
- Nancy have conceded three or more goals on five occasions this season.
- Nancy have won none of the last 44 matches in which they have conceded the opening goal since managing it in a 3-2 win over Caen in October 2010.
- AWAY FORM: Nancy are 18th in the away form table with four points from 10 games. Only fellow bottom three clubs Reims and Troyes have fared worse on their travels, none of the trio having yet recorded a road win.
- The four draws: 1-1 v Lille Wk 2, 3-3 v Troyes Wk13, 1-1 v Evian Wk15, 1-1 v OL Wk17.
- Nancy's last away win was 2-0 at Dijon in Week 31 last season.
- ASNL have drawn both away games in which they've scored the first goal this season.
- They have scored in each of their last six away from home.
- COUPE DE LA LIGUE: Nancy went out at the Round of 32 stage, losing 3-2 at Rennes.
- COUPE DE FRANCE: Nancy are through to the Round of 16 of the French Cup. They were 4-2 winners on penalties at Nice in the Round of 32 after a 2-2 draw. Alexy Bosetti, on a rare start, finished after being set up by Didier Digard to open the scoring with seven minutes on the clock. However, Nancy were back level by the midway point in the first half when Benjamin Moukandjo intercepted a Joris Delle pass bound for Renato Civelli before providing the equaliser on a plate for Paul Alo'o Efoulou. Alo'o Efoulou then netted his and Nancy's second early in the second half, and that goal seemed certain to win the game for Patrick Gabriel's beleaguered side. However, Dario Cvitanich popped up in the seventh minute of injury time to make it 2-2 and force extra time. With no further scoring in the extra period, the match went to penalties. Cvitanich and Timothée Kolodziejczak both missed from 12 yards for the hosts, before Vincent Muratori converted the decisive kick to take Nancy through.
- Nancy were 5-1 winners at DH (D6) side Dreux in the Round of 64.
- Nancy are at AS Minguettes Vénissieux (CFA2, D5) in the Round of 16 on February 26 or 27.
- JANUARY TRANSFERS IN: Yassine Jebbour has been signed on loan from Rennes.
- OUT: Club captain André Luiz left the club after the 2-2 draw v Lille. Yohan Mollo has joined Saint-Etienne on loan, Massadio Haïdara went to Newcastle United, ENG on a permanent deal and the same applied to Helder (Internacional, BRA) and Simon Zenke (Istanbul BB, TUR).
- INJURIES: Jordan Loties (foot) missed the Lorient game. Thomas Ayasse (illness) and Benjamin Moukandjo (ankle) both missed training in midweek but are expected to be OK to face OM.





Olympique de Marseille

- Olympique de Marseille ended last season in tenth place on 48 points, some 26 points off third place. It was their worst finish to a campaign since they ended the 2000-01 in 15th place on 40 points, just above the relegation zone in an 18-team top flight. They had been sixth, nine points off top spot at the winter break, but a winless run of 13 league matches during the second-half of the campaign put paid to any ambitions of challenging.
- Marseille have been crowned Ligue 1 champions nine times (1937, '48, '71, '72, '89, '90, '91, '92, 2010) - second only to Saint-Etienne who have ten L1 titles.
- OM are also the most successful club in the history of the Coupe de France with ten crowns (1924, '26, '27, '35, '38, '43, '69, '72, '76, '89). They won the Coupe de la Ligue for the first time in 2010 before becoming the first team to win the trophy back-to-back in 2011, and then completed a hat-trick of consecutive titles in 2012, beating Olympique Lyonnais 1-0 in the final.
- OM were stripped of the Ligue 1 title in 1993, after being found guilty of match-fixing.
- Last season OM reached the quarter-finals of the Champions League, losing 4-0 on aggregate (0-2, 2-0) to eventual runners-up Bayern Munich.
- Didier Deschamps' tenure as coach was brought to an end over summer 2012 with Elie Baup appointed as his replacement. Baup guided Girondins de Bordeaux to the Ligue 1 title in 1998-99 and also won the 2001-02 Coupe de la Ligue while in charge between 1997 and 2003 at Stade Chaban-Delmas. He has also coached AS Saint-Etienne (1994-96, 2004-06), Toulouse FC (2006-08) and FC Nantes (2008-09). Since being sacked by Nantes, he had been working as a media pundit before taking the reins at OM.
- Marseille are the only French club ever to win Europe's number one club prize, the European Cup or Champions League, when they defeated AC Milan 1-0 in 1993, thanks to a second-half header from defender Basile Boli.
- Marseille have also made three other continental cup finals: in 1991 they lost the European Cup final against Red Star Belgrade on penalties, they were beaten by Parma in the UEFA Cup final in 1999, then lost to Valencia in the showpiece of the same competition five years later.
- Renovation work on the Stade Vélodrome began over the summer of 2011. The 267 million Euro project - due to finish in 2014 - will see all four stands given a roof and increase the stadium's capacity to 67,000 ahead of EURO 2016.
- The club's major shareholder Robert-Louis Dreyfus died on July 4 2009 after a long illness. Dreyfus' wife, Margarita, is now the club owner.
- Argentine international Lucho Gonzalez became the club's record signing when he joined from Portuguese champions Porto in July 2009 for a reported fee of 18 million Euros.

AS Nancy-Lorraine

- Nancy returned to the top flight in 2005 after five seasons in Ligue 2.
- Season 2012-13 is Nancy's 29th in France's top division.
- Patrick Gabriel was named interim coach after Jean Fernandez, who'd been in charge for 18 months, left the club on January 10 2013. Gabriel was formerly reserve team coach, head of recruitment and, from May 2012 until his nomination as interim coach was in charge of the club's youth system.
- Season 2011-12 saw Nancy finish in 11th place, three points behind tenth-placed Marseille and seven points atop the drop zone. Romanian international striker Daniel Niculae top-scored with six strikes, Benjamin Moukandjo and Bakaye Traoré each nabbing five.
- Nancy were knocked out of the Coupe de la Ligue 2-1 at home to Auxerre in the round of 32 and were eliminated from the Coupe de France 3-0 in Rennes in the round of 64.





- Season 2010-11 was the first that Nancy played on the new synthetic surface at the Stade Marcel-Picot which, along with Lorient's Stade Moustoir, was the first Ligue 1 stadium to switch from traditional turf pitches.
- In season 2007-08, Nancy equalled their highest-ever Ligue 1 finish of fourth place (also 1976-77), registering the best defensive record in the club's history, conceding just 30 goals in 38 games and qualifying for the UEFA Cup.
- Nancy, under Pablo Correa, won the 2006 Coupe de la Ligue, defeating Nice 2-1 in the final at the Stade de France.
- Nancy won the Coupe de France in 1978.
- Without a Ligue 1 title to their name, Nancy have won the Ligue 2 title on four occasions: 1975, '90, '98 and 2005.
- Former France captain and current UEFA President Michel Platini played for Nancy between 1972 and 1979. Platini, the only player to win the European Footballer of the Year award (Ballon d'Or) three years in a row in 1983, '84 and '85, remains the club's all-time leading goalscorer with 81 goals.
- Current Arsenal manager Arsène Wenger was coach at ASNL from 1984-87.

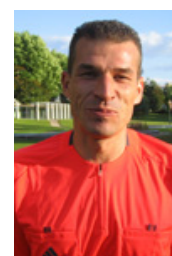
